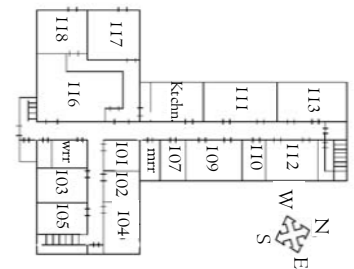

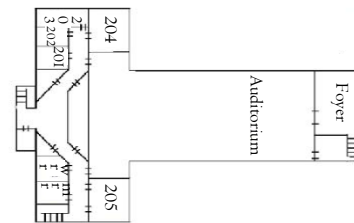

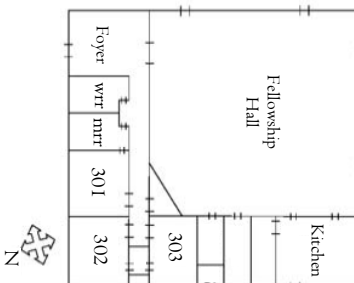
### Building A - Ground Floor

**The Five Solas of the Reformation**  
*Salvation is by grace alone, through faith alone, on the Word alone, because of Christ alone, and to the glory of God alone.*

**Sola gratia** – Grace alone - Salvation is an unearned gift that comes only by grace, not through any merit on the part of the sinner.

**Sola fide** – Faith alone - Justification comes through faith only, not good works.

**Sola scriptura** – Scripture alone - The Bible is the only inspired, inerrant, and authoritative Word of God.

**Solus Christus** – Christ alone - Christ is the exclusive mediator between God and man.

**Soli Deo gloria** – Glory to God alone - All glory is due to God alone, since salvation is accomplished solely through his works.
