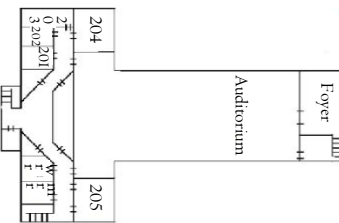

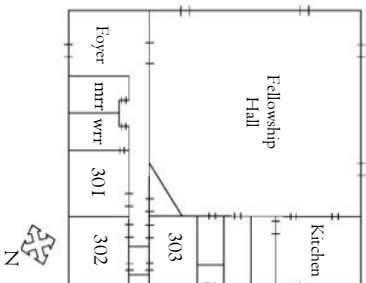
### Building A - Ground Floor
