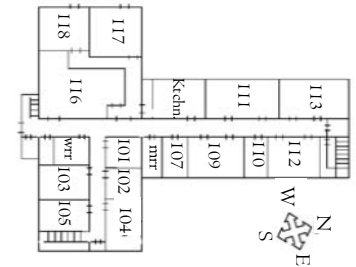

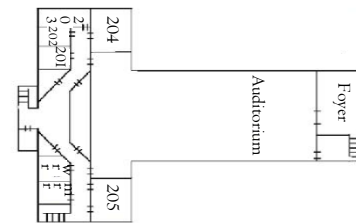

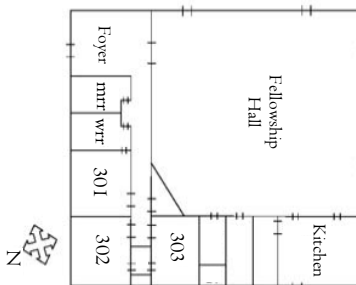
Building A - Ground Floor

The Five Solas of the Reformation
Salvation is by grace alone, through faith alone, on the Word alone, because of Christ alone, and to the glory of God alone.

Sola gratia – Grace alone - Salvation is an unearned gift that comes only by grace, not through any merit on the part of the sinner.

Sola fide – Faith alone - Justification comes through faith only, not good works.

Sola scriptura – Scripture alone - The Bible is the only inspired, inerrant, and authoritative Word of God.

Solus Christus – Christ alone - Christ is the exclusive mediator between God and man.

Soli Deo gloria – Glory to God alone - All glory is due to God alone, since salvation is accomplished solely through his works.
