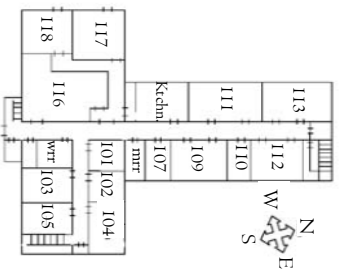

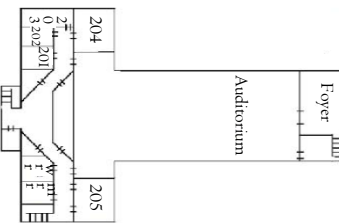

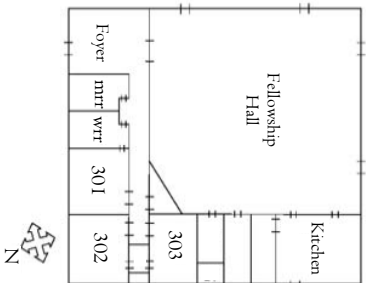
Building A - Ground Floor
