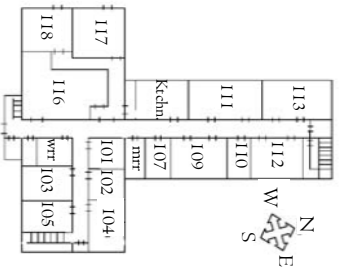

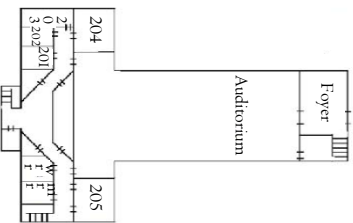

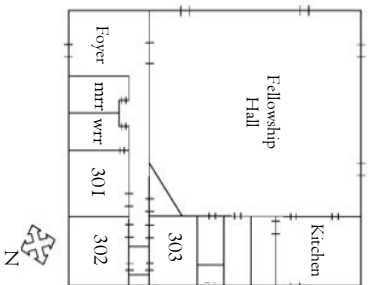
**Building A - Ground Floor**

### CHILDREN'S SUNDAY SCHOOL LESSON

Passage: Matthew 3:13-17

Principle: Jesus the Messiah was sent by the Father to provide salvation to those who believe.
