

Five Unanswerable Questions

Romans 8:31-39 – Part I

I. God is the believer's Guardian ("If God is for us, who is against us?").

- Whoever is against us will not prevail.

II. God is the believer's Provider ("how will He not also with Him freely give us all things?").

- It is impossible for God to fail us.

III. God is the believer's Justifier ("Who will bring a charge against God's elect?").

- The question is not "who will accuse us?"

IV. God is the believer's Sanctifier ("Who is the one who condemns?").

- There is no condemnation because of the penalty of sin or the power of sin.

V. God is the believer's Glorifier ("Who shall separate us from the love of Christ?").

- Present sufferings can't cut us off from God.
