I. The love of Christ for us is not threatened by any of the miseries of this life (v. 35).

II. The love of Christ for us is proven by His Word not by our experiences (v. 36). (“Just as it is written” Psa. 44:22)

- Christ never loves His people more than when He allows them the honor to suffer for Him.

III. The love of Christ for us is proven by His sufferings for us (v. 37).
