I. How shall they call upon Him in whom they have not believed?

- There must be a calling upon God for salvation.
- The sinner can’t call on God for salvation without faith in Christ?

II. And how shall they believe in whom they have not heard?

- There must be a hearing about Christ.

- You can’t experience saving faith without encountering the Christ of the Bible in the gospel message.

III. And how shall they hear without a preacher?

- There must be someone to proclaim the gospel.
- God is not going to write the gospel in the sky.
- General revelation (God’s revelation in nature) is not enough. God uses people, not angels, to carry the message of salvation.

IV. And how shall they preach unless they are sent?

- God is the one who commissions the messengers? How does this happen?
- Paul quotes Isaiah 52:7. How beautiful are the feet of those who bring glad tidings of good things!
