

# All Israel Will Be Saved

## Romans 11:25-27

- I. Israel's future restoration is assured by the completion of Gentile conversions (v. 25).
  - The divine mystery is to be a correction to human conceit.
  - Gentile conceit – “We have displaced Israel and are now God's special people with promises from God.”
  - The divine mystery includes Israel's partial hardening.
  - The divine mystery includes the fullness of the Gentiles.

- The divine mystery includes the future salvation of Israel.

- II. Israel's future restoration is assured by the conversion of Israel (vv. 26-27).

- “All Israel” refers to the totality of national Israel.
- “All” refers to a maximum number of Jews who will be saved out of that single generation living at the time of the Second Coming of Jesus Christ.
- “All Israel will be saved” (Isa. 59:20-21; 27:9; Jer. 31:33) – This is salvation from sin (Matt. 1:21).

How should we then live?
