MISC. INFORMATION

Spending Money: Please keep in mind that the registration cost for the retreat provides transportation, all meals at the camp, overnight lodging for the week, all off-campus (i.e., Six Flags) and on campus activities, Summer Camp sessions, and Summer Camp T-shirt. Apart from these provisions the student is responsible for all additional expenses: three meals on the road (Monday lunch, Friday Lunch at Six Flags (\$10 meal voucher), and Friday dinner), gift shop purchases, snacks, etc. (Encampment suggests bringing quarters for soda machines—when a coke machine needs exact change it needs exact change). We leave the amount of spending money to be brought with the student to be up to the discretion of each family. Student Ministries is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.

- All students need to turn in \$10 for Six Flags meal voucher on Monday during check-in
- If your activity is shotgun shooting you will need to bring \$15 for ammunition

Medicines: Berachah will be bringing their own first aid supplies: including band-aids, pain meds, sinus meds, etc. If you have special medications or inhalers please bring them in a clearly labeled bag.

Weather: Covington, GA – low 90's in the day and mid 70's in the evening. Scattered T-storms all week (it's going to be a wet one!). All buildings are air-conditioned.

PACKING LIST

(please label all items) – ONE SUITCASE PER PERSON – label your bag with name & church

- Students please note that this year our lodging format is more old school camp— large cabins, bunk beds, and larger groups of people. There will be no private rooms with locked doors this year. **We are not expecting theft to be an issue but please take this into consideration when packing.**

- Money for LUNCH on the road MONDAY – July 26**
- \$10 for check-in (meal voucher for Six Flags)**
- Bible, notebook, & pens – A camp notebook will be provided for note taking, but you may wish to bring your own spiral notebook, etc.
- Sturdy, close-toed shoes – students, all activities require such footwear. May get dirty—GA clay!
- Shoes for our day at Six Flags
- Casual clothing (modest shorts; no spaghetti strap shirts)
 - Student Ministries has the right to ask students to change clothing that is not deemed appropriate.
- Plenty of recreational clothing (4 days on campus – GA clay!)
- Rain gear – *it's supposed to rain*
- Twin bed linens and pillow – NOTE: a sleeping bag would suffice, but bed linens would probably be more comfortable.
- 1 Beach towel and 1 bath towel
- Quarters: exact change for drink machines
- Toiletries
- Alarm clock
- Sunglasses
- Sunscreen and bug spray
- Flashlight w/batteries (will need this for one of the evenings)
- Spending money (see note above)
- Camera (opt.)
- Swimsuit – (**modesty is a must**, girls—one pieces with shorts, guys—well if any of you are contemplating immodest swimwear we need to talk)
- Snacks—snack stand will also be open
- Camera (opt.)
- Tennis equipment (if desired)
- Fishing gear (catfish pond)
- Camera (opt.)

Students may bring CELL PHONES this year (see note below)

Brief comment regarding cell phones: All cell phones will be turned-in at BBC's camp registration and kept in Wade's possession during the week of camp. Cell phones will be returned to each student on Friday for our outing to Six Flags.

Students you will be able to survive a week without texting your friends—trust me! Parents if you need to reach your teen please feel free to call Wade's cell phone (770-841-8743). If needed, students will have access to a cell phone at all times via one of their camp leaders.

Rules:

- Adherence to all camp rules.
- Must always move from location to location with a "buddy" (the "buddy-system" includes groups of 2 or more with groups of 2 never including members of the opposite sex).
- Guys and girls may never be alone together or paired off.
- Students may not wander off alone.
- Guys may not enter a girl's room and vice versus.
- Students may not touch a member of the opposite sex in either forms of rough-housing or affectionate touching.
- Students may not wander off to unapproved locations. Approved locations will be covered at the campsite.

The following infractions will necessitate immediate parent pick-up from camp:

- Any violent act directed at another person.
- Physical displays of guy-girl affection.
- Significant acts of rebellion.
- Persistent breaking of camp rules.
- Entering a room of the opposite sex.
- Any other significant disciplinary issue deemed by the leaders as worthy of immediate withdrawal from camp.
